Interdisciplinary Research Teams

Health problems today are often not discipline specific and require a team approach to (a) identify the correct methodological approaches, (b) have the access to population data sets to pursue the most pressing research questions, and (c) create synergy of expertise to pursue complex research questions. As a nurse researcher, it is beneficial to garner the skills needed to pursue research with interdisciplinary teams. I have had the pleasure of participating or leading several interdisciplinary research teams. Based on these experiences, it is critical to clarify each team member's role in the study as the first step. This may seem obvious yet it doesn't always occur. Here are a few pearls that may be helpful as you develop your own interdisciplinary research teams or join an interdisciplinary research team.

The first tip, or pearl, for finding interdisciplinary colleagues starts with your statistician. Statisticians often collaborate with colleagues in other disciplines and have inside information on interdisciplinary colleagues who are strong collaborators. Ideally, the statistician can provide potential collaborators early in the planning stage of a proposal development. Involving interdisciplinary colleagues early in the grant planning is a crucial step for inclusion in the grant budget.

Word of mouth is another method for finding strong interdisciplinary colleagues. This is most effective when investigators are looking for an interdisciplinary colleague who is local. Experts may not be at your home institution

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The emergence of the iSchool movement and the establishment of iSchools have helped to reshape the landscape of the library and information science (LIS) discipline. In this article, based on a set of research questions focusing around the research and education efforts of about 25 iSchools, we performed a study using both quantitative and qualitative methods on publically available data obtained from the web. Our results show that iSchools share the same vision and mission of working on relationships between information, people and technology, and have established themselves as the appropriate institutions for researchers from diverse subject areas to study this interdisciplinary integration. Overall, we are seeing an emerging iSchool identity and a defining iField, but there are still many important developments to make.
